

THE AADAAB OF RECITING THE HOLY QUR'AN

- The reciter of the Holy Qur'an must perform the ritual ablution (wudhu).
- The intention when reciting the Holy Qur'an should be to gain the pleasure of Allah.
- The voice should not be raised to such an extent where your recital will disturb others who are also engaged in some form of worship.
- The reciter of the Holy Qur'an must sit in a dignified position facing the Ka'bah.
- When commencing with the recitation of the Holy Qur'an – start by reciting:

“ I seek Allah's protection from Satan, the accursed. ”

أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ

And thereafter recite:

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

“In the name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful.”

The place of origin (مَخْرَجُ / مَخَارِجُ)

Of the Arabic letters

To know the origin of any letter of the Arabic Alphabets, place a Sukoon (◌ْ) on it and precede it with an Alif (ا) with a Fatha (َ).

Example: أَبْ will give us the origin of the letter بْ

TAJWEED

Reciting the Holy Qur'an with TAJWEED means to pronounce every letter with all its articulative qualities such as the correct prolongation, merging, conversion, distinctness, and pauses. Reciting the Qur'an with TAJWEED allows the reciter to emphasise the accent, phonetics, rhythm and temper of the Qur'anic recitation.

QALQALA

When the letters of QALQALA has a Sukoon (◌ْ) on it, it will be read with an echoing or jerking sound.

The letters of QALQALA are:



In the examples that follow, the QALQALA letter with a Sukoon appears in the red block. Care should be taken when reciting, not to jerk the letter to the extent where it will sound as if the letter has a FATHA on it.

When a stop is made at the end of the sentences below, the rule of QALQALA will apply. The last letter becomes SAAKIN irrespective of the vowel sign, thus resulting in the QALQALA letter being read with an echoing or jerking sound.

NOON and MEEM MUSHADDADAH

When the letters ن and م has a SHADDAH (ّ) on it (نّ مّ) it will be recited with Ghunna. The nasalization should not exceed the duration of two harakah. (2 - 3 second duration).

THE RULE OF THE LETTER LAAM

When a letter with FATHA (ـَ) or DHAMMA (ـُ) appears before the name of ALLAH, it will be pronounced with a broad sound or full mouth.

When a letter with a KASRA (ـِ) appears before the name of ALLAH, it will be pronounced with a thin sound or an empty mouth.

THE RULE OF MEEM SAAKIN (م)

There are three rules regarding the MEEM SAAKIN م

1. IKHFA SHAFAWI
2. IDGHAAM SHAFAWI
3. ITHAAR SHAFAWI

1. IKHFA SHAFAWI – MEEM SAAKIN

When the letter Ba (ب) appears after a MEEM SAAKIN (م) there will be IKHFA SHAFAWI. It will be pronounced with a light nasal sound in the nose for a duration of 2 harakah. (2 - 3 second duration).

2. IDGHAAM SHAFAWI – MEEM SAAKIN

If after a MEEM SAAKIN (م) there appears a MEEM MUSHADDADAH (م), IDGHAAM will occur. In other words, the two MEEMS will become incorporated and be read with GHUNNA (nasalization).

3. ITHAAR SHAFAWI – MEEM SAAKIN

When after a MEEM SAAKIN (م) there appears any of the 26 letters other than the letters BA (ب) and MEEM (م) there will be ITHAAR SHAFAWI. No GHUNNA will occur.

IKHFA – NOON SAAKIN AND TANWEEN

If any of the 15 letters of IKHFA below come after a Noon Saakin (نْ) or Tanween (ً ٍ ٌ) the word must be read with a light nasal sound in the nose for a duration of two harakah. (2 - 3 second duration).

When after a NOON SAKIN (نْ) or TANWEEN (ً) there appears any of the HUROOF HALQIYAH letters (throat letters) then it will be pronounced without GHUNNA (no nasalization.)

IDGHAAM – NOON SAAKIN AND TANWEEN

IDGHAAM refers to the assimilation of one letter into the other. The rule of IDGHAAM will apply when the letters **ي ن م و** is preceded by a NOON SAAKIN (نْ) or TANWEEN (ً / ٍ / ٌ). The emphasis will be on the succeeding letter because of the presence of a SHADDAH (ّ) and will be read with GHUNNA. The nasalization should not exceed the duration of two harakah.

(2 - 3 second duration).

IDGHAAM MITHLAYN (Assimilation of the same kind)

This rule applies when two letters following each other are the same. The first letter has a SAAKIN (۷) and the second letter is vocal and has a SHADDAH (۷) on it. When reciting the letters keep in mind that the SAAKIN letter becomes assimilated into the letter following it.

IDGHAAM MUTAQARIBAYN (Assimilation of letters with similar origin)

This rule applies when a letter in a word is SAAKIN (۷) and the letter following it has a SHADDAH (۷). When pronounced it appears to be close to the same place of origin as the SAAKIN letter. The SAAKIN letter will assimilate with the vocal letter when recited.

IDGHAAM MUTAJAANISAYN (Assimilation of related kind)

This rule applies when a letter in a word is SAAKIN (س) and the letter following it has a SHADDAH (ش) and when pronounced has the same place of origin as the SAAKIN letter. The SAAKIN letter will assimilate with the vocal letter when recited.

MADDUL MUTTASIL

The joined madd

When a HUROOFUL MADD letter (ا و ي) is followed by a HAMZA (ء) in the same word, the MADD is known as MADDUL MUTTASIL.

If after any HUROOFUL MADD letter (ا و ي) there appears a SAAKIN which is caused by a WAQAF (stop) then such a MADD is known as MADDUL AARIDH. The length of recitation of the MADDUL AARIDH will be tawassut (intermediate) i.e. 2 to 5 HARAKAAT long. (2-5 second duration)

THE SUN LETTER

When the definite article (اَلْ) is attached to an indefinite word, the TANWEEN (ةُ) changes into a short vowel eg. شَجَرَةٌ شَجَرَةٌ

An indefinite word, eg. شَجَرَةٌ beginning with a SUN LETTER and with the definite article (اَلْ) attached to it, (اَلشَّجَرَةُ) results in the LAAM (ل) not being pronounced.

The ALIF (ا) in the definite article (اَلْ) is recited and merges with the SUN LETTER which now has a SHADDAH (ّ) on it when recited. eg. اَلشَّجَرَةُ

The SHADDAH (ّ) sign is an indication that the pronunciation must be hardened.

However, if the definite article (اَلْ) is preceded by a word or letter then it will not be pronounced.

eg. تَحْتَ الشَّجَرَةِ

THE MOON LETTER

When the definite article (اَنَّ) is attached to an indefinite word, the TANWEEN (ة) changes into a short vowel eg. الْمَسْجِدُ مَسْجِدٌ

An indefinite word, (eg. مَسْجِدٌ beginning with a MOON LETTER and with the definite article (اَنَّ) attached to it, (الْمَسْجِدُ) results in the LAAM (ل) being pronounced as a LAAM SAAKIN (لْ). The ALIF (ا) in the definite article becomes HAMZA TUL WASL i.e. the ALIF (ا) is written, but is not pronounced when a word or letter precedes it eg. فِي الْمَسْجِدِ

However, if the definite noun (الْمَسْجِدُ) appears as the first word in a sentence then the ALIF will be pronounced.

When the letter ب appears after a مّ it will be pronounced with a light sound in the nose.



Idghaam

If after a نْ or ؤْ there appear any of these letters (ي ن م و) it will become assimilated into the letter and will be read with Ghunna.



Qalqala

The five letters of Qalqala are ق ط ب ج د
When any of these letters in a word has a Sukoon on it or if deciding on pausing on any of these letters which appear at the end of a sentence it will appear to have an echoing or jerking sound.



Qalb

If after a نْ or ؤْ the letter ب appears then the Noon Saakin or Tanween will be incorporated into the letter مّ an will be recited with Ghunna.



Idghaam Meem Saakin

If after a مّ there appear another مّ the two meems will become incorporated and will be read with Ghunna.
